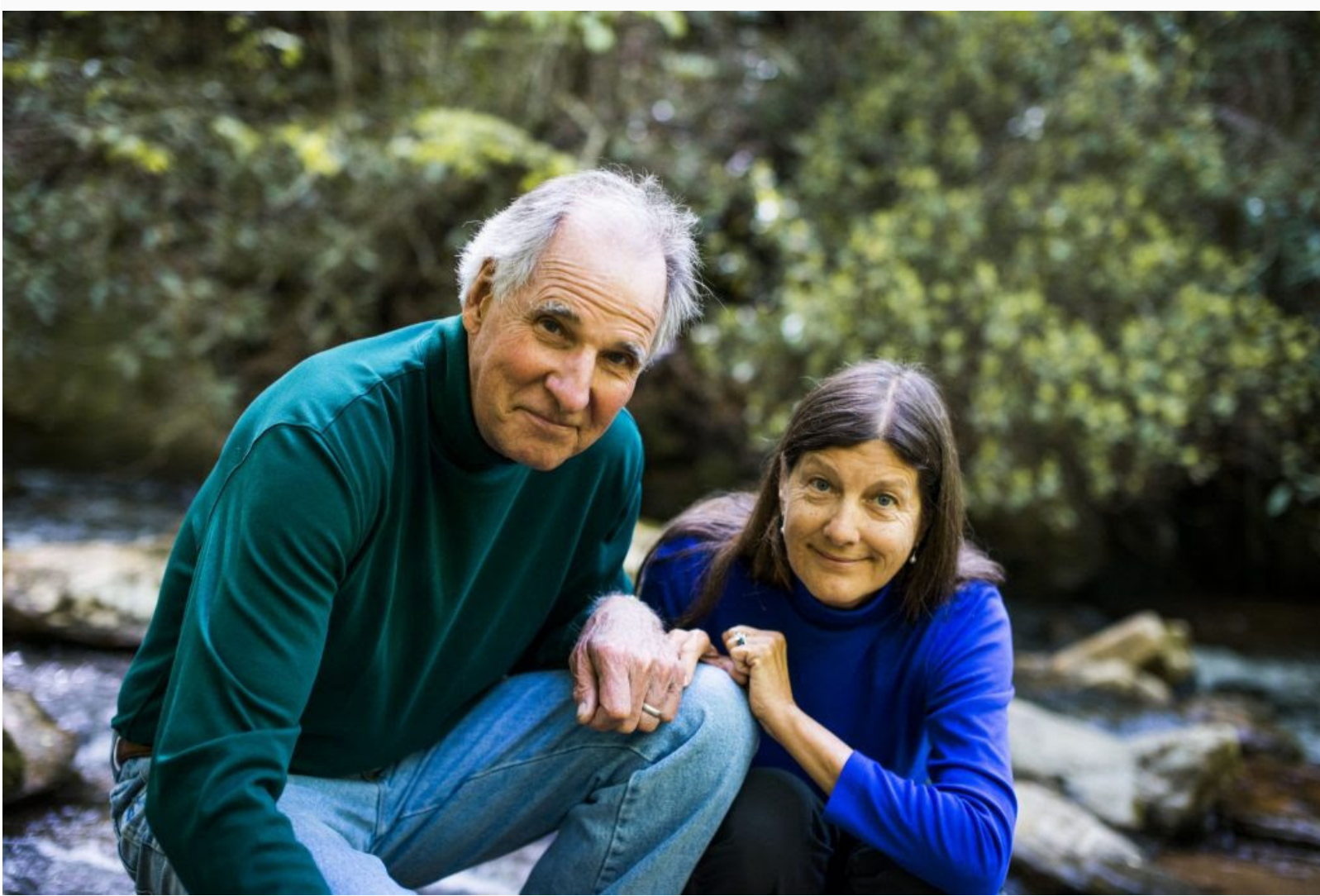




Changing the game for endangered wild gorillas is a collaborative effort, with conservationists and environmentalists across the globe doing their part every single day to protect these amazing creatures.

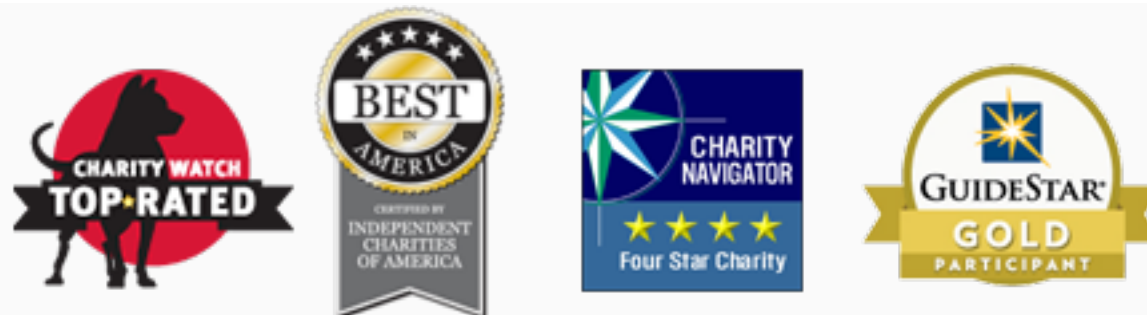
